1.0 Policy:

Health Plan covers preventive health services to adults and children, as required by the ACA.

Certain preventive health services require prior approval for coverage.

2.0 Background

The Affordable Care Act (ACA) requires individual and group health plans to cover network preventive health services and immunizations without a member cost-share (e.g., deductibles, coinsurance, and copayments) unless the plan qualifies under the grandfather provision or for an exemption. Coverage for preventive health services other than those mandated by ACA is dependent on benefit plan language.

The preventive health services listed in this policy are based on recommendations from:

- United States Preventive Task Force (USPSTF), grade A or B recommendations.
- Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

- Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA).
- Latest medical research from organizations like the American Medical Association (AMA).
- Pharmacy Benefit Manager.

3.0 Clinical Determination Guidelines:

1. Preventive health services do not incur a member cost share when they are all the following:
 - a. Listed in this policy.
 - b. Done for preventive purposes (not diagnostic).
 - c. Completed by a network provider.
2. Some services MAY require prior approval. See table below.
 - a. Screening versus diagnostic, monitoring or surveillance testing.

A positive result on a preventive screening exam does not alter its classification as a preventive service but does influence how that service is classified when rendered in the future. For example, if a screening colonoscopy performed on an asymptomatic individual without additional risk factors for colorectal cancer (e.g., adenomatous polyps, inflammatory bowel disease) detects colorectal cancer or polyps, the purpose of the procedure remains screening, even if polyps are removed during the preventive screening. However, once a diagnosis of colorectal cancer or additional risk factors for colorectal cancer is identified, future colonoscopies will no longer be considered preventive screening.

3. Reporting of preventive care services.

Preventive health services are reported with diagnosis and procedure codes, which identify the services as preventive and not for treatment of injury or illness (see code chart below). Age, gender or frequency limits are utilized for certain designated services (i.e., wellness exams, vision and hearing screening, administration of Human Papillomavirus [HPV] vaccines, nutritional and genetic counseling). Preventive health services submitted with diagnosis codes that represent treatment of illness or injury are paid as applicable under member's normal medical benefits rather than preventive care coverage.

4.0 Coding:

5.0 Unique Configuration/Prior Approval/Coverage Details:

Preventive health claims require the modifier 33 to be considered payable as a preventive service. However, PHP does not process claims based solely on the presence of modifier 33.

Preventive health services are dependent upon claim submission using preventive diagnosis (when applicable) and procedure codes in order to be identified and covered as preventive health services.

G0438 – Annual wellness visit; includes a personalized prevention plan of service, initial visit covered as a Preventive Service for Metal Plan members.

G0439 – Annual wellness visit, includes a personalized prevention plan of service, subsequent visit covered as a Preventive Service for Metal Plan members.

6.0 Terms & Definitions:

Diagnostic service. Done to monitor, diagnose or treat a health problem. A deductible, copayment or coinsurance may apply. The following are examples of diagnostic services:

- Management of a chronic condition such as diabetes.
- Follow-up tests ordered by a doctor after a preventive screening determined a health problem.
- Follow-up tests ordered by a doctor based on symptoms, such as abdominal pain.

Preventive health service. Screenings, tests, and services performed for symptom-free or disease-free individuals. They may also include immunizations and screening services for individuals who are symptom-free or disease-free and are at increased risk for a particular disease. There is no cost to the member.

Wellness examination. Well-baby, well-child, well-adult (including well-woman) examinations that include:

- An age- and gender-appropriate history.
- Physical examinations.
- Counseling/anticipatory guidance.
- Risk factor reduction interventions.
- The ordering of appropriate immunizations and laboratory/screening procedures.
